This year, McShane Construction Company reached an incredible milestone: our 40th anniversary. In those 40 years, we grew from a small industrial design-build firm into one of the nation's largest general contractors, serving more than 30 states and building in the industrial, multifamily, commercial, health and fitness, and institutional sectors. However, it is not statistics that define our success.

Throughout this year, we took time to reflect on The McShane Way – the principles that Jim McShane built this firm on in 1984 and that still guide us today. MIDWEST REGION

The Foglia Residences Completed in Chicago

Construction is completed at The Foglia Residences for clients Brinshore Development and The Chicago Lighthouse. Located in Chicago's Illinois Medical District, the development incorporates 76 affordable apartments for residents who are blind, visually impaired, disabled, and veterans. The development is the first Low-Income Housing Tax Credit building in the nation for the blind community.

Units are offered in studio, one-, and two-bedroom floorplans. Features include solid surface kitchen countertops for added durability, appliances with front controls and tactile operation, dimmable lighting, contrasting flooring, and contrasting finishes for the appliances, cabinets, and countertops.

To make the residence fully accessible, the common areas offer contrasting colors, lit braille unit signage, handrails on both sides of the corridors, braille wallpaper, braille numbering on the mailboxes, and accessible elevators with audible signals.

SOUTHEAST REGION

OSLO Luxury Apartments Completed in Fairburn, Georgia

McShane completed the construction of OSLO, a 288-unit multi-family complex in Fairburn, Georgia, for repeat client South City Partners. The development integrates five threeand four-story garden-style buildings with stone and fiber cement siding.

Units boast open-concept layouts with one to three bedrooms. Apartment features include shaker-style cabinets with granite countertops and French-door refrigerators in the kitchens, and tile tub/shower surrounds in the bathrooms. Each unit provides vinyl plank flooring in the common areas and carpeted bedrooms.

With more than 7,000 square feet of amenity space, residents can enjoy a heated saltwater pool, fitness center, clubroom, pickleball courts, dog park, pet spa, and walking trail. Additionally, the development offers 4,000 square feet of retail space.

Manor Scottsdale Completed in Scottsdale, Arizona

Located in Scottsdale, Arizona, Manor Scottsdale is a 286-unit apartment complex recently completed for Related Group.

Offered in one- to three-bedroom layouts, units boast sleek quartz countertops, smart home technology, and private balconies. The building offers 32 penthouse apartments, 19 apartments with mountain views, and 24 Kosher apartments.

Amenities include a state-of-the-art fitness center with yoga and spin rooms, a wellness center with a sauna, a club room with a kitchen, and a game room with an arcade and golf simulator. Outside, residents can enjoy a resort-style swimming pool, grotto, and summer kitchens, and pet owners can take advantage of the dog park and pet spa. The community also offers electric vehicle charging stations and a smart package room with cold storage.

McShane Selected to Build 329-unit Multi-Family Development in Madison, Wisconsin

Construction has begun at Lock Lane Apartments, a 309-unit multi-family community in Madison, Wisconsin, for Vermilion Development.

Located adjacent to Tenney Park, the development will integrate two five-story podium-style buildings with a total of 289 units and three two-story townhome buildings with 20 units. The podium buildings will feature four levels of wood framing atop a two-level precast parking garage.

Residents will enjoy balconies, quartz countertops, in-unit washer/dryers, and spacious closets. Many units will offer lake, park, or river views.

Amenities will include large green roof areas, fitness centers, fifth-floor club rooms and common balconies, co-working office spaces, conference rooms, and heated vehicle and bike parking. Additionally, the site will offer a fenced dog run, community gardens, and access to both the lake and riverfront.

History of McShane

After graduating with a degree in Civil Engineering from Marquette University in 1968, Jim McShane's career in construction was launched. In 1978, after spending the first decade of his career in Minnesota and Milwaukee, he relocated to Chicago where he identified a lack of design-build construction providers with the capacity to support the sizable corporations that were relocating or expanding in the area. It was upon this idea that Jim founded McShane Construction in 1984 with the goal of offering comprehensive design-build services.

While we have grown significantly since then from a small design-build contractor to one of the top 100 construction firms in the nation, we have never forgotten our roots and are still known for our design-build approach today.



Located near Milwaukee, this affordable housing residence will offer 203 units in a four-story podium-style building with underground parking.



This build-to-suit industrial building will feature 372,000 square feet of manufacturing and distribution space on a 25-acre site.



Recently completed in Stockton, California, this three-building speculative development offers nearly 1.1 million square feet of industrial space.



This mixed-use community will integrate three buildings offering 332 apartments and 15 ground-floor commercial units near Nashville.

Construction is nearing completion at this 347-unit apartment community that incorporates five apartment and 10 townhome-style buildings.
